

What's New in SharePoint 2019

How to evaluate the business benefits of the new release to inform your migration strategy

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INTRODUCTION

With SharePoint Server 2019, Microsoft now delivers to its on-premises customers many of the enhancements provided over the past few years in SharePoint Online. Built on the same core platform as SharePoint Online, SharePoint 2019 is designed to deliver a new, modern experience for users.

In this whitepaper, I'll explore the key new features available in SharePoint 2019 and why moving to the new release can benefit your organization. Then, I'll explain how you can ensure a quick, secure migration with ZeroIMPACT to your users and business with best-in-class tools from Quest and Metalogix.

NEW AND ENHANCED FEATURES

Communication sites

My favorite feature in SharePoint 2019 by far is the communication sites. SharePoint has always been a great collaboration platform, enabling people to easily work together on files, lists and libraries. However, over the years I've heard

many customers say that, although SharePoint is great for document storage and management, it wasn't a good option for their intranet because they weren't able to easily build the sites they wanted or an engaging landing site for the company.

That assessment of previous SharePoint versions was perfectly fair. Sites had to be designed and built as either team sites with publishing enabled or fully structured publishing sites. Customizing a site's functionality and navigation required a team of experienced designers and developers to create master pages, cascading style sheets (CSS), JavaScript code, web parts and so on. Moreover, sites designed for a browser on a PC often did not work well or look good on mobile devices — so even more time and resources were needed to build, test and deploy classic publishing sites that would work well in today's mobile world.

The communication sites in SharePoint 2019 remove all of those barriers, giving you a great way to share news, showcase stories and broadcast messages in a visually compelling format — without spending thousands of dollars on developers or design

agencies. Communication sites don't rely on the publishing site infrastructure, so users can create the sites they want in seconds, without ever needing to contact IT. They can simply click Create site on SharePoint Home and then use the intuitive interface to adjust page layouts, add web parts, and even pull in content from other services, like conversations from Yammer and videos from Microsoft Stream.

Moreover, the sites are optimized to look — and work — great both on the desktop and on mobile devices. Whether you want to build a compelling, interactive experience for thousands or tens of thousands of external people or a site that facilitates more intimate dialogues and sharing, the communication sites feature makes it a snap.

My second favorite new feature in SharePoint 2019 is Fast Site Creation. In the early days of SharePoint, users had to ask their SharePoint administrator to create sites for them — and then sit and wait until their request bubbled to the top of the priority list. That's no longer the case. The Fast Site Creation feature in SharePoint 2019 enables users and administrators alike to create new sites in seconds, including OneDrive personal sites, Team sites (modern only) and communication sites. There are three ways to access this functionality:

- OneDrive personal site auto-provisioning
- The Create Site button in SharePoint Home
- The New-SPSite PowerShell cmdlet

By taking advantage of Fast Site Creation, organizations can be far more agile in responding to emerging business needs. Plus, by shifting much of the burden of site creation from IT staff to end users, this new feature can free up IT resources to focus on more strategic projects.

Modern user experience

SharePoint 2019 delivers a consistent user experience across Windows, OneDrive and SharePoint. Having a consistent look and feel across the Microsoft platform enhances user productivity and satisfaction because everyone can easily find the buttons, features and options they need. Moreover, as noted earlier, sites look and work

great on mobile devices as well as desktops, which is essential in today's BYOD world.

Modern lists and libraries

The new release also includes the modern lists and libraries that have been available in Office 365 for some time, bringing the experience up to date with that found in SharePoint Online. The default list and library experience is optimized for the most common tasks — in particular, users can easily copy and move files, pin documents, add files as links, filter and sort, and apply formatting to columns.

Beyond that, the new lists simplify the way individuals and teams access, share and interact with structured data by providing a rich set of capabilities that work across devices and browsers. The modern libraries are faster and more responsive, and more intuitive as well, with a UI similar to OneDrive. Users can easily create new folders and upload files in their browser, and the ribbon has been replaced with a command bar that provides intelligent commands relevant to the tasks at hand.

Now, it's easier than ever to build workflows around lists and libraries because they are integrated with Microsoft Flow and PowerApps, the top process management tools in the Microsoft ecosystem.

Modern search experience

SharePoint 2019 still supports the classic search experience, but it introduces a modern search experience that users will love. As they start typing in the search box, results appear right away and are updated as they enter more details in the search. Moreover, it's a federated search, so if you have a hybrid SharePoint deployment, users don't need to know or even care whether the documents they want are on-premises or in the cloud. The modern search is available on the SharePoint home page, communication sites and modern team sites.

OneDrive and personal site OneDrive sync

In earlier versions of SharePoint, OneDrive was not as robust as organizations would have liked, and it had significant



synchronization issues. For example, there were problems if a file name was too long or included special characters.

SharePoint 2019 resolves all those issues. OneDrive is robust, works reliably, and can be used on both desktops and mobile devices. The hash sign (#) and percent sign (%) are supported in file and folder names in both SharePoint 2019 and OneDrive for Business, and the URL path length restriction has been increased from 260 Unicode code units to 400. The OneDrive sync client is marvelously easy to use, yet it supports advanced features such as Files On-Demand, push notifications and IRM protection. In fact, the sync feature works so well that organizations will be able to retire Box, Dropbox and other enterprise file sync and share (EFSS) solutions and consolidate on their Microsoft portfolio. By simplifying their IT ecosystem, the organization can reduce IT overhead, reduce costs, and enhance user productivity and satisfaction.

SharePoint home page

In the past, users had to use bookmarks to keep track of their favorite SharePoint sites. Now, they can easily create a beautiful SharePoint home page that gives them unified access to all their sites, both on-premises and in the cloud. From a single pane view, they can quickly catch up with what's been going on within their teams and projects, navigate seamlessly through their intranet, and get a personalized view of news from the sites they're following, as well as recommendations for additional sites that are likely to be of interest. As noted earlier, the SharePoint home page also features a Create site button that enables users to create sites in seconds without any help from IT.

SharePoint mobile app

Finally, there's the new SharePoint mobile app, which enables users to stay connected and informed — even when they're on the go. They can stay engaged with their team sites and get notified when someone posts a comment on a page they authored or responds to a comment they have made. In addition, they can quickly open and preview Office documents, "like" news posts or modern pages, and view their SharePoint calendar. In short, the SharePoint mobile app puts the intranet in the user's pocket.

SHOULD YOUR ORGANIZATION INVEST IN SHAREPOINT 2019?

Clearly, SharePoint 2019 has a lot of new features and functionality to offer. But does it make much business sense to adopt it? After all, Microsoft has made it abundantly clear that its focus is the cloud — in this case, SharePoint Online. Why bother to upgrade your on-prem deployment at all?

The very existence of SharePoint 2019 is evidence that many organizations are not yet ready or able to fully embrace the cloud. For a variety of reasons, including both practical and security concerns, they are choosing to maintain either an exclusively on-premises SharePoint environment or a hybrid deployment. In either case, there are compelling reasons to upgrade to the new on-premises version of SharePoint: you'll see a sound return on investment (ROI), you will reduce risk significantly, and you'll position your organization for a move to SharePoint Online in the future.
