

Directory Sync Pro

Introduction

Directory Sync Pro sets up and maintains a sync between multiple systems. It can sync Active Directory forests or Active Directory. Now, users in merging organizations can find each other in a shared address book. With Directory Sync Pro, you can efficiently sync all mail-enabled objects, including users, contacts, mail groups, distribution lists, databases, shared mailboxes, rooms, and resources.

Features

- Sync mail-enabled objects between environments for better collaboration and productivity
- Sync between Active Directory forests
- AD attribute data transformation with overrides and custom mappings
- Sync passwords and/or SID History*
*Password sync requires RC4 encryption protocol
- Policy Enable/Disable target MEUs
- Restructure AD without end-user impacts
- On-premises install for cloud sensitive scenarios
- Multi-node setup available for redundancy
- Browser based UI for remote administration

- ‘What if?’ dry-run Sync Report
- Reduce risk by testing with environments which mimic production
- Unified Global Address List, calendar free/busy, and cross-forest delegation Sync
